A useful book, written from the standpoint of a Christian philosopher, indicating the role of reason
in several different schools of philosophy is

C. Stephen Evans, *Faith Beyond Reason*

A highly recommended book on the philosophy of thinking (i.e., thinking about thinking) is

Hannah Arendt, *The Life of the Mind*
