## Select Bibliography in the course Philosophy for Understanding Theology

Useful one-volume surveys are Anthony Kenny, *A Brief History of Western Philosophy* Bertrand Russell, *History of Western Philosophy* 

A multi-volume work, always reliable, whose scope is the same but gives much more detail, is Frederick Copleston, *A History of Philosophy* 

A useful book, written from the standpoint of a Christian philosopher, indicating the role of reason in several different schools of philosophy is C. Stephen Evans, *Faith Beyond Reason* 

A highly recommended book on the philosophy of thinking (i.e., thinking about thinking) is Hannah Arendt, *The Life of the Mind* (This book, however, presupposes considerable familiarity with philosophy.)
